Collins Resigns At WPGC, Mason Named New PD

Jim Collins has resigned as Program Director of strike-torn WPGC/ Washington. According to Collins. "Management asked me to resign my membership in AFTRA and go on the air, which would have made me a strikebreaker." The station, plagued by an AFTRA strike of several weeks' duration, has brought Den Mason from Z-93/Atlanta, to assume the PD position. Collins, who had been fulfilling management duties off the air during the strike, will remain at WPGC during the transition.

In other WPGC developments,.

R&R has learned that Music Director Jim Elliott has crossed the
AFTRA picket line and has gone
on the air. Elliott will apparently
remain MD at WPGC. In addition,
an entire new staff of non-union
jocks has reportedly been hired
at the station.

Mason told R&R: "I have cherished all the years at Z-93, but I now feel I must take the opportunity to move up and rebuild WPGC

back into the great radio station it most recently was." Present WPGC management personnel had no comment on the situation.
